## TRANSFER PATHWAY GUIDE 2024-2025

Associate of Science in Human Services - Social Work (TSAP) To  
Bachelor of Science in Human Services and Addictions

### ***Overview***

Completion of the following curriculum will satisfy the requirements for the Associate of Science (AS) in Human Services – Social Work (TSAP) degree at Ivy Tech Community College (ITCC) and leads to the Bachelor of Science (BS) in Human Services and Addictions degree at Northern Kentucky University (NKU).

### ***Applying to the IvyTech2NKU Program***

Students can apply to participate in the pathway program by completing the online application on the NKU transfer webpage. Students must be enrolled in at least six credit hours at Ivy Tech, enrolled in an associate degree program, plan to transfer to NKU, and maintain a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA at Ivy Tech.

### ***Degree Requirements for Ivy Tech***

To earn a degree at Ivy Tech a student must successfully complete the required number of credits for the degree, attain a minimum GPA of 2.0 in the required technical and general education courses, and complete at least 15 degree credits in the curriculum as a regular student of Ivy Tech.

### ***Admission Requirements for NKU***

Students completing an associate degree with a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher will be accepted into NKU.

### ***Degree Requirements for NKU***

Students must successfully complete all required human services and addictions courses and all program-required supportive courses with a grade of C- or better and have a minimum GPA of 2.5 to graduate with a Bachelor of Science in Human Services and Addictions. At least 45 credit hours must be 300 level or above. Students must meet the pre-requisites for each course. At least 25 percent of the total required hours and the last 30 credit hours must be completed at NKU. Students must complete a minimum of 120 credit hours. Students must complete a focus or minor as indicated on the pathway.
